If side placement isn't practical, place your surround speakers a few feet behind your listening position and face them forward. You'll want your surrounds one to two feet above ear level to get the best sound effects. Place your surround speakers 1 to 2 feet above ear level for immersive special effects.

Speaker Placement for Home Theater Surround Sound

The remaining two speakers should be placed slightly behind your home theater seating. If you are using a 7.1 system, the 6th and 7th speakers should be placed right behind the audience. The rest of the arrangement remains the same as that of a 5.1 system.

Dolby Atmos speaker layouts parallel the 5.1 and 7.1 setups for surround sound. A 5.1.2 or 7.1.2 system uses two ceiling speakers, or two Dolby Atmos-enabled speakers or modules. A 5.1.4 or 7.1.4 system uses four ceiling speakers, or four Dolby Atmos-enabled speakers or modules. A 9.1.2 system adds a pair of front wide speakers to a 7.1.2 layout.

To complete your home theater setup, you need to place and connect the speakers and subwoofer. First position your speakers and subwoofer, but be careful not to place them flush against any walls.
